

# The Big Story of the Bible

The Bible is divided into the Old Testament and the New Testament. There are thirty-nine books in the Old Testament and twenty-seven books in the New Testament, totaling sixtysix books. Together these books form one big story about life on this earth with a beginning, middle, and end. The Bible's big story has three parts: Creation, Fall, and Redemption.

Genesis 1-2 tell about the Creation of our world and everything in it. The Fall and Redemption—the middle and end of the Bible's story—take up the whole rest of the Bible.




