## BEFORE READING



### Big Idea

An article often includes features to help the reader understand the information.

#### Informational Text Features

**Section title:** breaks up information and helps the reader find the main idea

**Caption:** helps explain a photograph

**Sidebar:** gives additional information that helps the reader understand the main text of the article

**Diagram:** a labeled drawing that helps the reader understand how something looks or how it works



### Genre

### Informational text

Informational text is nonfiction and provides facts about a subject. An informational article may be divided into sections with a stated main idea in each section.
