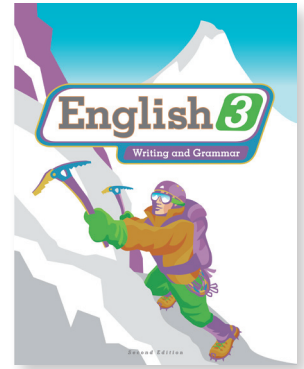

Scope & Sequence Updates

- Parts of speech: Added abstract and collective nouns.
- Sentence structure: Added expanding sentences.
- Usage: Removed homophones, prefixes, and suffixes.
- Writing skills & support: Added voice, sentence fluency, and presentation to writing traits; a checklist for self-assessment; a rubric for summative assessment. Removed Plot Pyramid and using a dictionary.
- Writing projects: Added journal and reflection activities, which integrate biblical worldview theme with the skill focus. Removed writing a story and compare-contrast essay.
- Study & reference skills: Removed encyclopedia, atlas, and dictionary skills. Added internet research and internet safety.
- Listening, speaking, and viewing skills: Expanded to include collaborative discussions, think-pair-share, and active listening stories. Added visual analysis; image brainstorm; presentations with oral report with visual display, audio recording, and video recording.
- Biblical worldview: Added lessons, instruction, and activities to shape a biblical worldview of communication in relation to Creation, Fall, Redemption using themes of friendship, authority, work, celebration, and people.

Grammar Review

- Added two practice lessons to most grammar chapters.

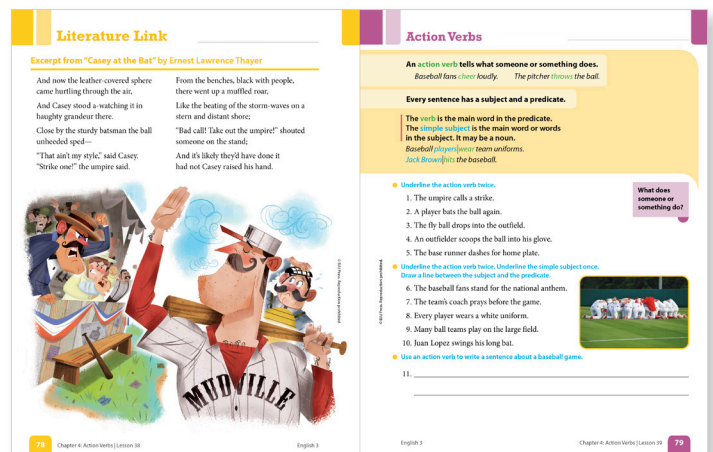
Teacher Edition

- The teacher edition has expanded from a one-part TE with 160 lessons to a two-part TE with 180 lessons.
- Instructional aids added to back of teacher edition.

Assessments

- Assessment packets now include only tests for the grammar chapters and research chapter. The writing chapters are graded with the new writing rubric located in the back of the teacher edition and on Teacher Tools Online.

- Chapters begin with a selection of informational, literary, narrative, or opinion texts. Used to promote literacy and introduce the biblical worldview focus as well as the grammar skill or writing genre for the chapter.
