1. A \_\_\_\_\_ **noun** names **any person, place, or thing** and begins with a **lower case** letter.
2. A \_\_\_\_\_ **noun** names a **specific person, place, or thing**. Each **important word** is **capitalized**.
3. A \_\_\_\_\_ **noun** names things you **can see** or **touch**.
4. An \_\_\_\_\_ **noun** names things that **cannot** be seen or touched such as **feelings** or **ideas**.
5. A \_\_\_\_\_ **noun** names a **group** of **people** or **things**.
6. A \_\_\_\_\_ **noun** names **one** person, place, or thing.
7. A \_\_\_\_\_ **noun** names **more than one** person, place, or thing.
8. A \_\_\_\_\_ **noun** shows **ownership**.
9. A \_\_\_\_\_ is a word **used in place** of **one or more nouns** or **pronouns**.
10. A \_\_\_\_\_ is a **special kind** of **personal pronoun**. It shows **ownership** and **replaces** a **possessive noun**.
11. An \_\_\_\_\_ is the word or words to which a **pronoun refers**. It usually comes **before** the **pronoun**.
12. A \_\_\_\_\_ **pronoun refers** back to the **subject** used earlier in the same sentence. They end with **-self** or **-selves** and can be **singular** or **plural**.
13. A \_\_\_\_\_ **pronoun** points out **specific** people, places, or things. These are words such as **this, that, these, and those**.
