






*Look at a penny. How many times is **one** or **1** on it? What else do you notice about a penny?




Color the pictures that appear in the quantity of one.

*cloud, sun, hole in tree, squirrel, nut, mother duck, fish, pond




What do these pictures have to do with the number <u>one</u>?
