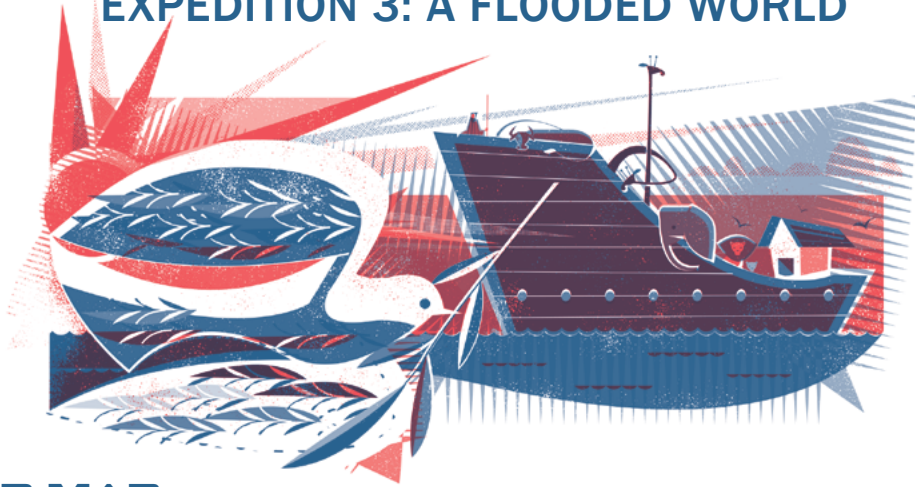


# EXPEDITION 3: A FLOODED WORLD

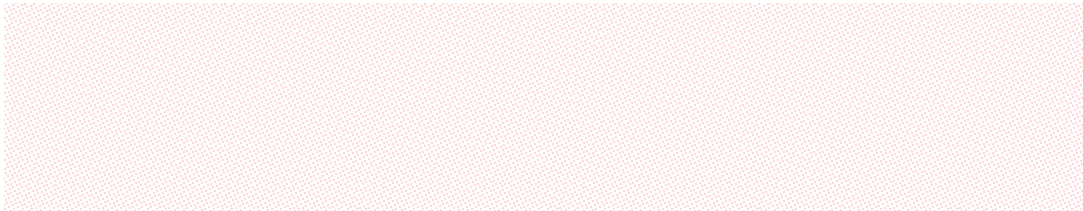
