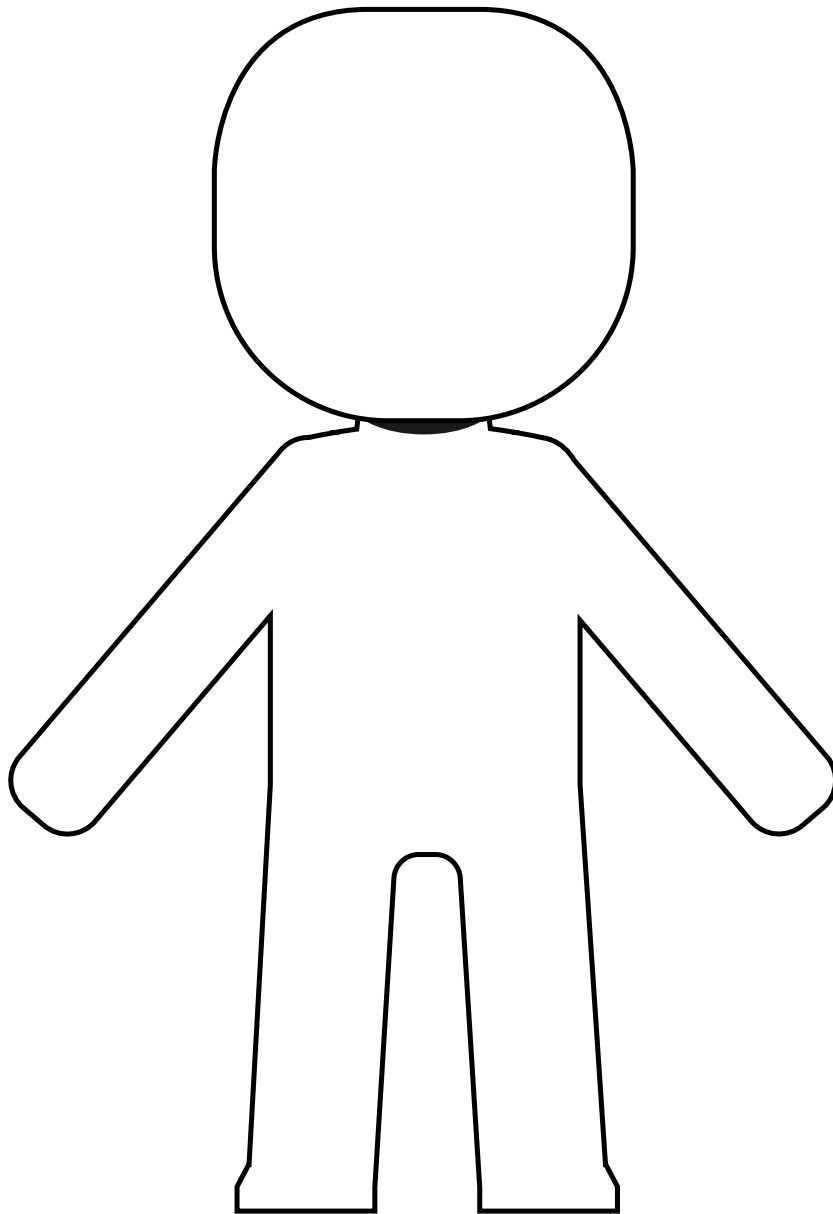
1. WHY YOU ARE SPECIAL

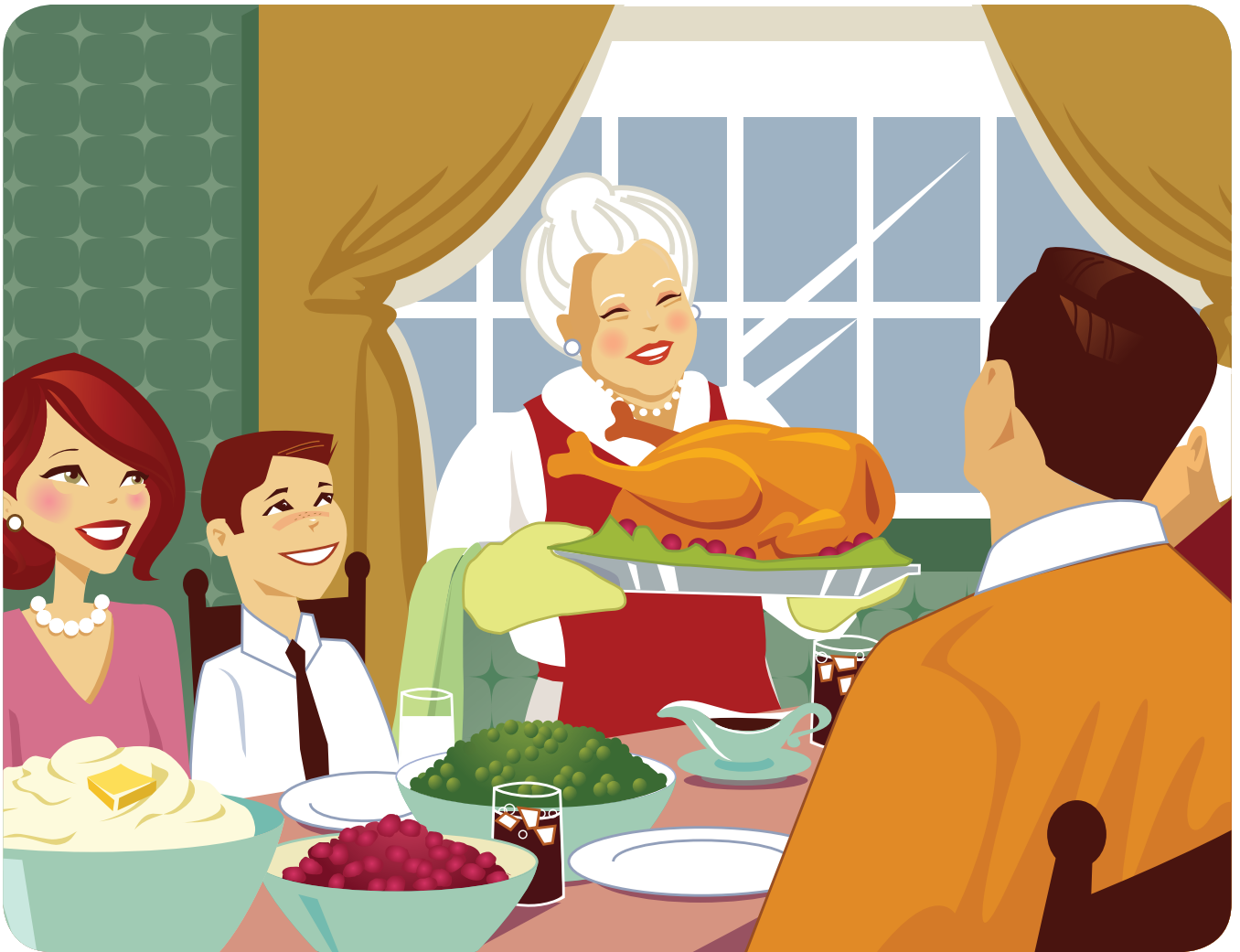

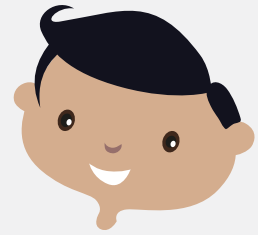
