

## From Adam to Us Timeline Book

This *Timeline Book* covers world history from Creation to the 21st Century. The scale of the timeline changes as you go through history. This means that earlier pages include more years than later pages. Each vertical gray bar on the timeline marks a century, or one hundred years.

A timeline assignment is listed at the end of most lessons in *From Adam to Us*. Each assignment will tell you the page to turn to in the *Timeline Book*. Find the box on that page that has the matching lesson number and copy the assigned statement on the blank lines. The timeline also includes other events from world history. Across the top of each page are black bars showing the lifespans of key people mentioned in the lessons. Some of the dates and lifespans are approximate, especially in the years before the coming of Christ.

You can keep all of the pages in the *Timeline Book* for reference, or you can remove the pages from the book and hang them in order on a wall.

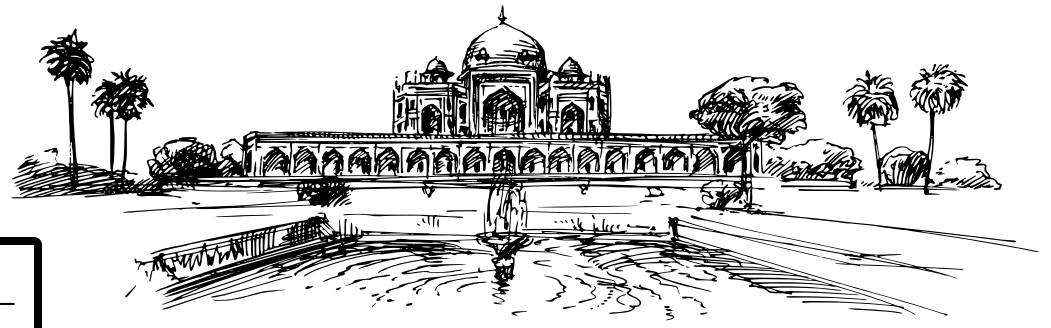
