This is Ann

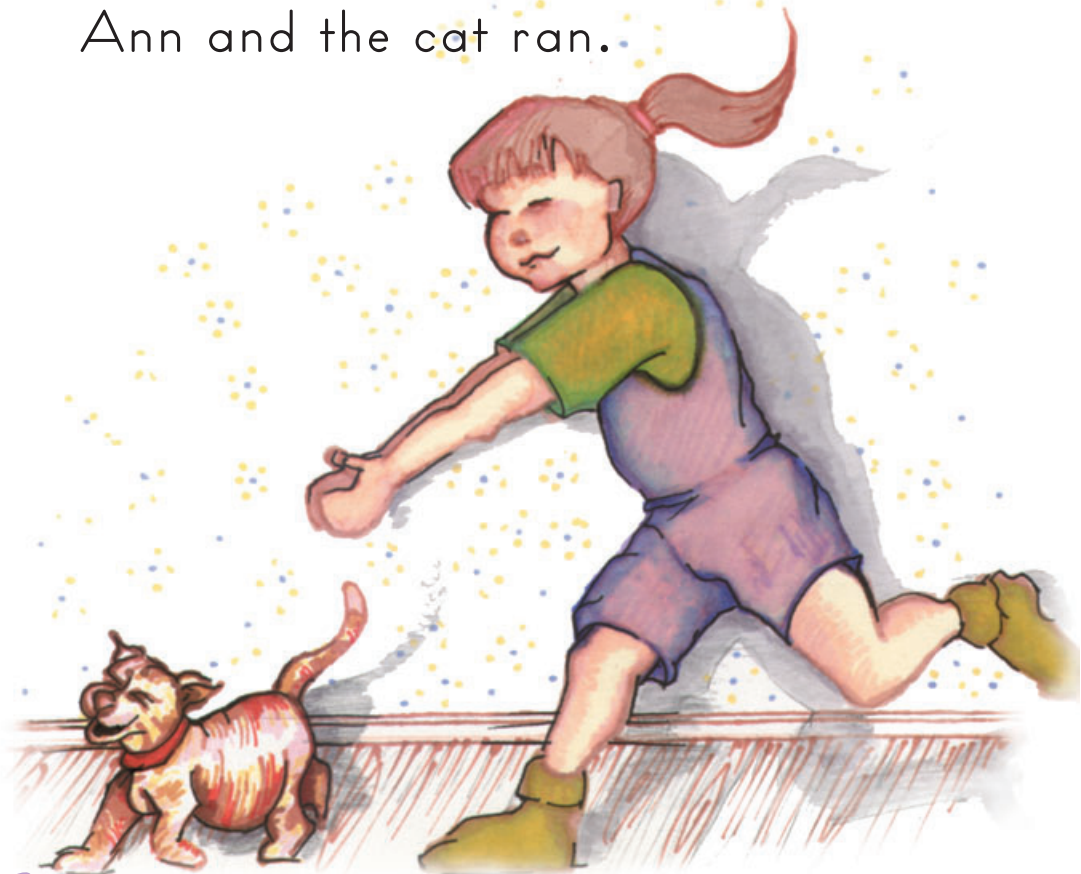
Ann has a cat.

I look funny.

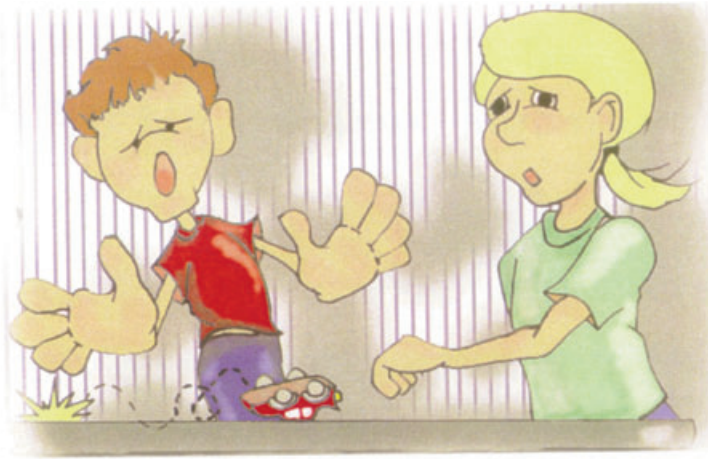
I will put the wig back in the box.”

Ken sent the toy car across the desk to Ann. Ann held it in her hands. Then she sent the toy car back to Ken with a wham!

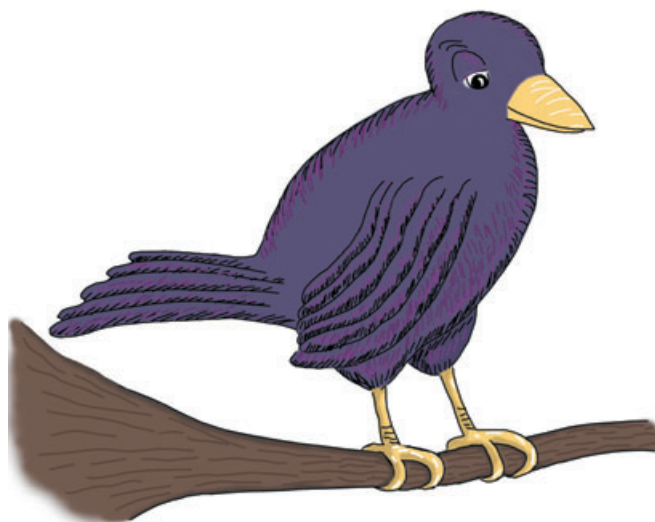


Ken said, “Be careful with my car. Do not wham it into the desk. This is the best toy car.”
