


Pick one of the following ideas to write a letter.

## THINKING ABOUT "IN FLANDERS FIELDS"



Lieutenant-Colonel John McCrae was a Canadian medical officer during the First World War. He was born in 1872 and was raised in Guelph, Ontario. John McCrae wrote the famous poem "In Flanders Fields" on May 3, 1915. He wrote it in honour of his close friend Lieutenant Alexis Helmer who was killed by an explosion during the Second Battle of Ypres in Belgium. John McCrae died of pneumonia in January 1918 and was buried with military honours in Wimereux, France.
