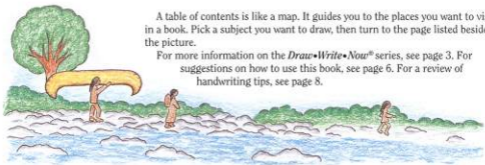


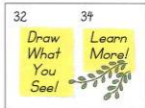
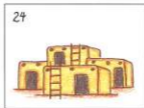
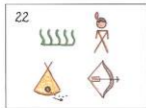
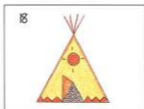
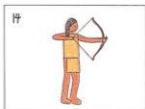
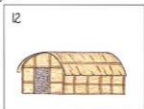
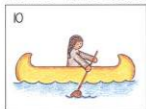
# Table of Contents
