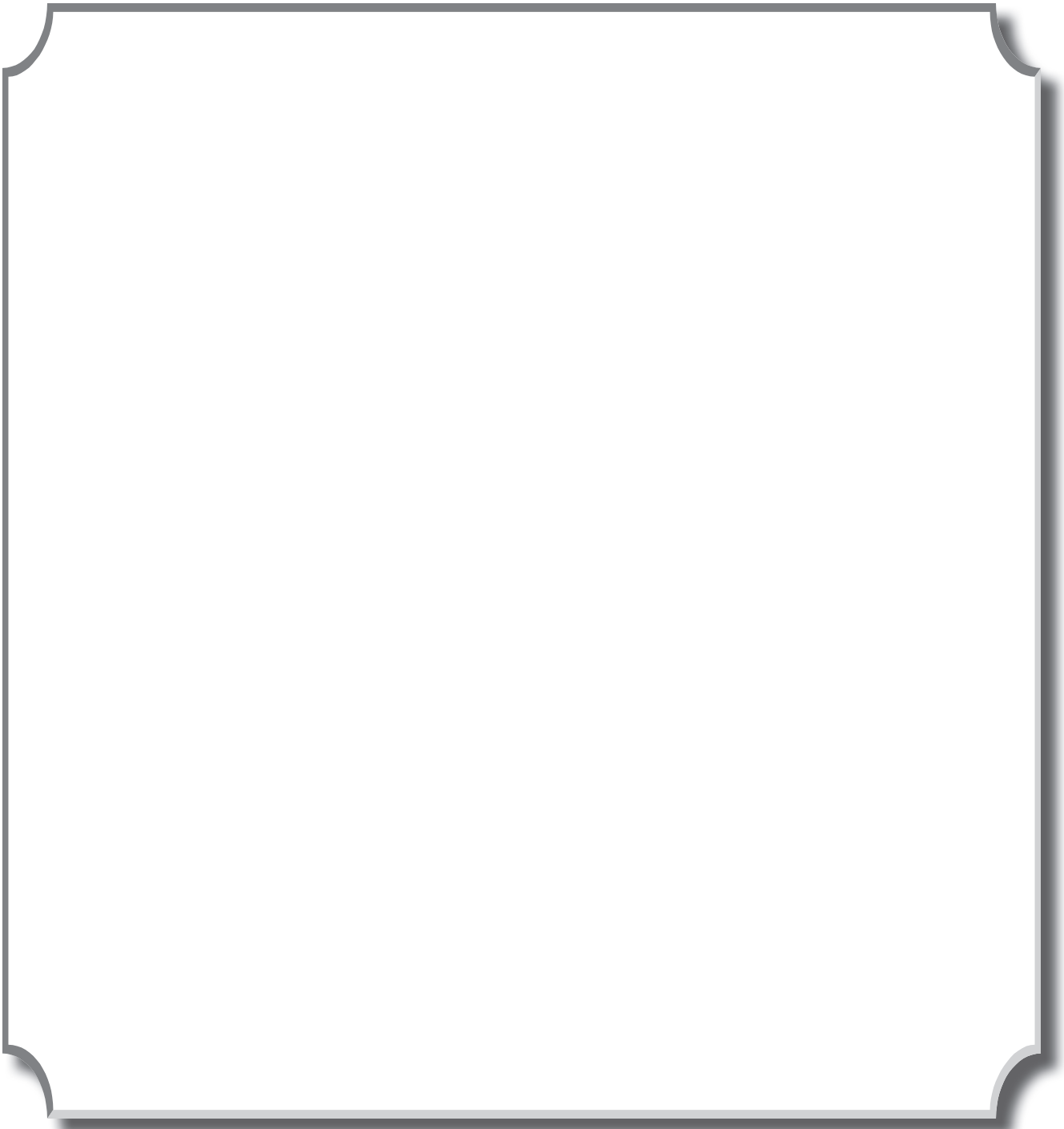

# Trace & Copy Horizontal & Vertical Lines
