Long-Vowel Rule: When a syllable has two vowels, the first one is usually long and the second one is silent. When a syllable has one yowel and it comes at the end of the syllable, the yowel is usually long.

Vowel Digraph: A vowel digraph is a set of two vowels which sound together to make one sound

\*Note: The workbook uses the popular spelling chaise lounge. However, the proper spelling of this term is chaise longue (literally, "long chair"); it is French for a couchlike chair that supports the back of the sitter and is long enough to support his outstretched legs.
