Vowel Combinations with o

Six vowel combinations start with o. Some of the combinations make more than one sound. Some of the sounds are spelled by more than one combination.

oa says /ō/ as in *road*

ow says /ō/ and /ow/ as in *owl* and *gown*

oi says /oi/ as in *coin*

oy says /oi/ as in *joy*

oo says /ōō/ as in *food*

ou says /ow/, /ə/, /ŭ/, and /ōō/ as in *mouse*, *touch*, and *you*
